Mental Health throughout Life

While there is almost universal agreement about its importance, mental health remains in Australia a sometimes under-resourced area of health care. This conference is an opportunity to consider mental health, to learn more about mental health care, and to affirm its importance.

This conference has two keynote speakers. The first is the Hon Jeff Kennett AC, chairman of beyondblue. Mr Kennett will speak about mental health services in the community.

The second keynote speaker is Robyn Humphries, Manager, System Transformation in the Mental Health Branch of the Victorian Department of Health. Robyn will give us a comprehensive introduction to Victoria's new legislation, the Mental Health Act 2014.

Other distinguished speakers will explore mental health care and support at critical times in the life cycle, including the perinatal period, school, and old age. A consumer and a pastoral care practitioner will offer their distinctive perspectives.

This conference will be of interest to doctors, nurses, health care managers, pastoral and spiritual care workers, chaplains, allied health professionals and support staff, especially those who work in primary care, community care, aged care and hospital care. It will be of interest to those who provide social services within the community. It will also be of interest to patients and health and aged care consumers who have had experiences of or who have concerns about mental health and mental health care.
